By the way, our last vet bill included charges for 9 scholarships: 3 dogs and 3 cats spayed and 2 dogs and one cat neutered. So that's a whole lot of puppies and kittens that won't be looking for homes in Petersburg. We also got the huskies in for their exams and shots. Each incoming animal goes to the vet for an exam and whatever is needed to make sure he or she is healthy and unable to reproduce.

In case you weren't aware, our phone number isn't staffed. A volunteer checks it at least once a day and calls are returned as quickly as possible. This is just one of the **volunteer opportunities** PHA offers. We're always looking for volunteers to spend some time with our critters to help get them ready (and stay ready) for adoption. When we have dogs, we need people to walk them and to feed them, water them and clean their kennels and runs. We post our pets looking for homes on bulletin boards around town, advertise them in the Pilot and announce them on Tradio. If you'd like to help with any of these activities, please call us. We'll be glad to put you to work.
