




April and May were busy months for PHA members, friends and board. They include two of the four **major fund raisers** of our year. (Warning: money plays a big part in this Update!)




The second annual flamingo flocking raised \$1645. The Little Norway bake sale brought in \$553.75. Thank you all for your generous support of both events. These proceeds, along with the \$50 raised by the Kids' Pet Art Contest and the silent auction at our annual membership meeting, **totaled \$2268.75**. They all help pay the day-to-day costs of sheltering and caring for Petersburg's homeless animals and fund our spay-neuter voucher program.

The **2015 Petersburg Pets Calendar** is the next fundraiser, and the deadline for getting your pictures in is less than a month away! **New shelter project.** The land the cat shelter sits on is going to be developed by the owner within the next year. It doesn't look like the existing buildings can be moved successfully. So the cats need a new building to live in while waiting for forever homes. Phase I of the permanent shelter planned for the old Tent City site is a 16' by 24' structure that will provide three enclosures for the cats, each with an outside yard. It will also include a small work space and limited storage for food, litter and bedding. Once the larger shelter is built, this space will be remodeled and connected to it to be used as needed.

The preliminary cost estimate for the structure is \$70,000.
